COMMUNITY HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Creating Awareness on Health and Hygienic is very important for our people in order to prevention them from infection of various diseases. With this motive Awareness programme on health in various rural community about

community health issues where community identified its health needs that included absence of basic health care services, sanitation, absence of toilets and hygiene for women and girls, infrequent immunization rounds etc. Free medical camps were organized for the rural community. Nearly 500 people were benefited under this programme.

HIV/AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The main goal of the programme was to promote sensitivity and awareness about HIV/AIDS among women and workers in the community, organized and unorganized sectors. Human welfare trust has also observed World health day on 1st December in Thiruchirapalli district . bit notice and handbills were distributed among general rural mass . We also arranged food for the people who were affected by AIDS. Human Welfare trust invited resource people to deliver the message on HIV/AIDS and its impact to the community. We have provided chance to all the participants to interact with the resource person to clarify their doubts on health. 14.02.2008 on behalf of “Velantines day”, “Notices and Handbills” has distributed to the people by indicating on Awareness of AIDS .

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME

Women have always been marginalized and relegated to the status of subjugated class in the Indian society. Due to lack of specific implementation of plans, local communities especially women have remained outside the scope and benefits of government schemes and programmes. The key lies in women empowerment through economic self-sufficiency and higher

awareness levels on social, political and legal issues through mobilization. Women should be organized and strengthened at the grass root level to end their subordination. Human welfare trust making an attempt in that direction to make rural women self sufficient through various skill training programmes.

AWARENESS ON CHILD LABOUR.

The main aim of this programme is to enhance the quality of life of children and youth through increased knowledge and skills. The trust also realized that merely imparting literacy would help the younger generation come up their life. Creating awareness on abolition of child labour will make some changes among parents and society to think. The youth need to be taught vocational training in school itself to uplift their status. They should be able to stand on their feet and provide for their families after they completed education. We have planning to start vocational training programme for the youth and women in future. On Children Day, we have organized special programme on child labour in schools. 1000 handbills and bit notice were distributed among public to impart the important of education for children and youth,.

PROGRAMME FOR YOUTH

The well -informed adolescents on sexual and reproductive health issues can play a decisive role in the better adolescent health in the country. We have educated and provide information to the adolescent rural girls about their reproductive and sexual health. An important component of the programme was to sensitize the parents and the community members to the needs of

adolescents, as they are the ones who make all the decisions. Our initiative also addressed immediate concerns of adolescents i.e. delaying early marriage and pregnancy by taking an integrated approach of providing education and skill training side by side.

HELPING THE AGED PEOPLE

Aged people need to take care by providing psycho-social support. Human Welfare trust has created awareness programme among school children like how we should take care of our aged people. On behalf of Mrs.Indira Gandhi Memorial Day, Human Welfare trust has provided Dhotis and Sarees for 25 adult and poor people on Trichirappalli.

AWARENESS ON PROHIBITION OF UNTOUCHABLES

On behalf of Memorial Day of Dr. Ambhatkar on Trichy Samayapuram , we have organized street play in order to impart the prohibition of untouchability in today's world. We distributed 1000 Bit notices to the general population by our volunteers on 6.12.2008
